Executive Committee Meeting September 8, 2003

Travel – Peter Cizdziel made a motion to accept Chris Hodge’s U/19 girl’s team into the PWHC travel program. The motion was seconded and passed. Peter made a motion that the girl’s U/14 team’s fees be established at \$875 for the season (to include 25 – ½ ice practices, 2 full ice practices, 7 home games and 2 non-league games). The motion was seconded and passed.

CBHL – Mike Dove reported that all Peewee and Bantam coaches must be Level 3+ and all Midget coaches must be Level 4+. Mike reported that the CBHL raised the travel team registration fee this year to \$225 per team. Players will not be required to sign the score sheet this year. The next CBHL meeting is scheduled for September 16, 2003. Mike and Steve Stewart will attend.

Communications – Angie Bailey would like to schedule a web page meeting in October. She will post a request for a used digital camera for PWHC use on the web page.

House Programs – Sean Evans requested approval to purchase 6 sets of water bottles and pucks. Sean made a motion for a budget of \$350 to be used to purchase these items for the house program. The motion was seconded and passed. Sean reported that House Evaluations were all ready to go. Mite and Mini-Mites begin on 9/20/03. He is still looking for coaches at the Squirt and Midget Divisions. He expects to field 4 house teams in Squirts, Peewees, and Bantams and 2 Midget teams. Sean has tried to reach Scott Warner from SkateQuest to coordinate the PWHC involvement for the House Christmas Tournament.

Secretary – Nancy McDonald made a motion to approve the minutes from the August 2003 meeting. The motion was seconded and passed. Nancy reported on the PWHC Golf Tournament for John and Lynn Hess. We still need golfers and corporate sponsors for the golf tournament that is scheduled at Fort Belvoir on October 10, 2003.

Inline – Mike Artist reported that the House League started play on September 7, 2003 with 18 teams in 4 divisions. Travel Inline starts their fall season next week. The Bob MacGregor Memorial Tournament that was held at Slapshotz was a great success. The PWHC fielded teams in every division.
